The Energy Policy Institute is accepting applications to fill at least two graduate assistantship positions for the **Fall 2008 semester**. Graduate assistants work 15-20 hours per week on research and training projects. In return, they are paid a stipend of approximately \$4,476 per semester and receive a waiver of registration fees for each semester, including out-of-state tuition.

To qualify as a graduate assistant, an applicant must be admitted to the Boise State University Graduate College and meet standards for admission to the Master of Public Administration (MPA) program. The applicant must complete an application file for admission to the MPA program by February 1. If selected for an assistantship, the student must be registered for at least nine credit hours (full-time) each semester.
